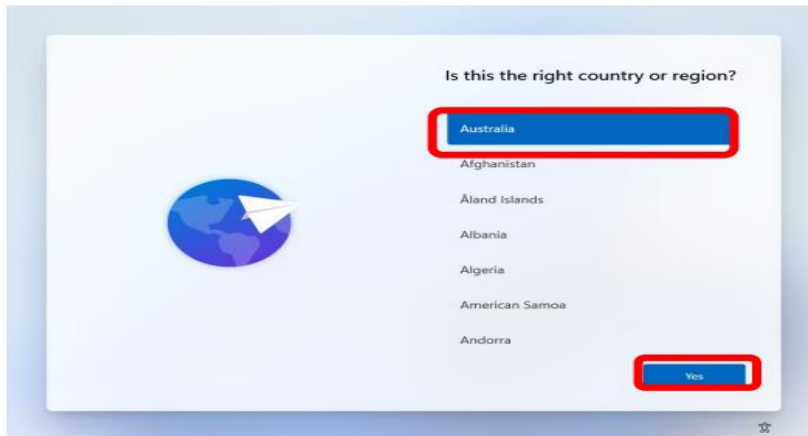
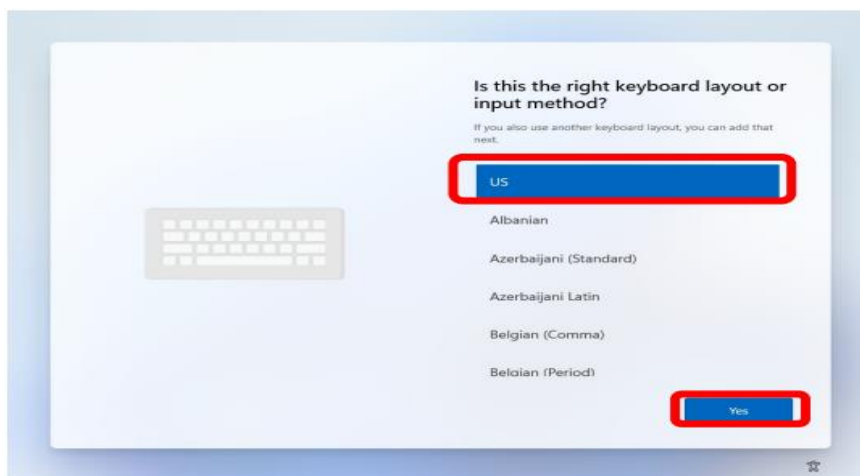


Set up Windows 11 without Microsoft Account

Step 1: Is this the right country or region? - Select "Australia" and select "Yes"



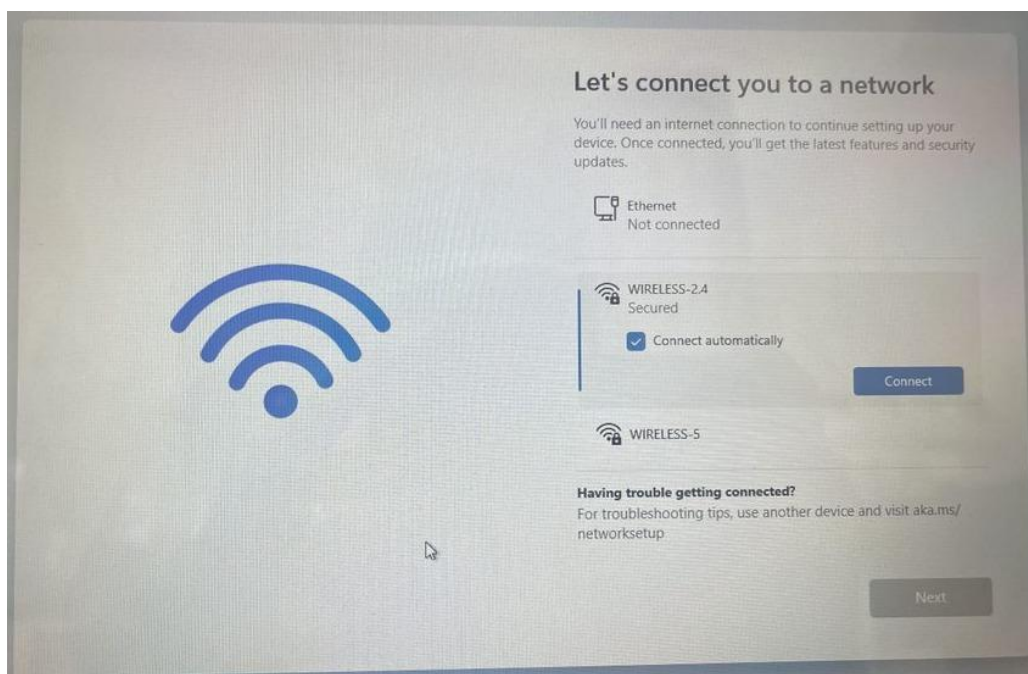
Step 2: Is this the right keyboard layout or input method? – Select "US" or "Unites States". Australia uses the same keyboard layout.



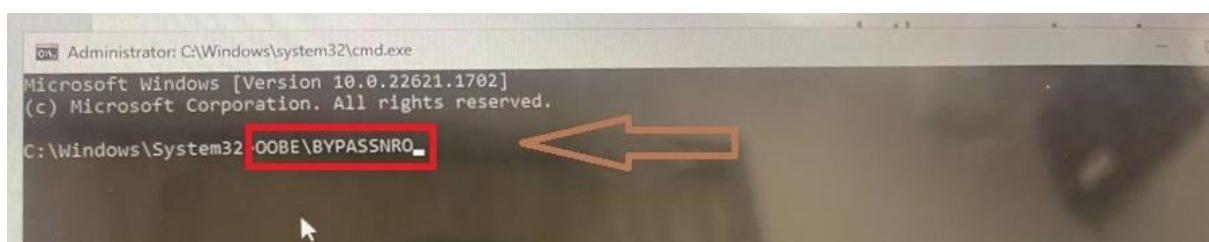
Step 3: Do you want to add a second keyboard layout? – Select "Skip".



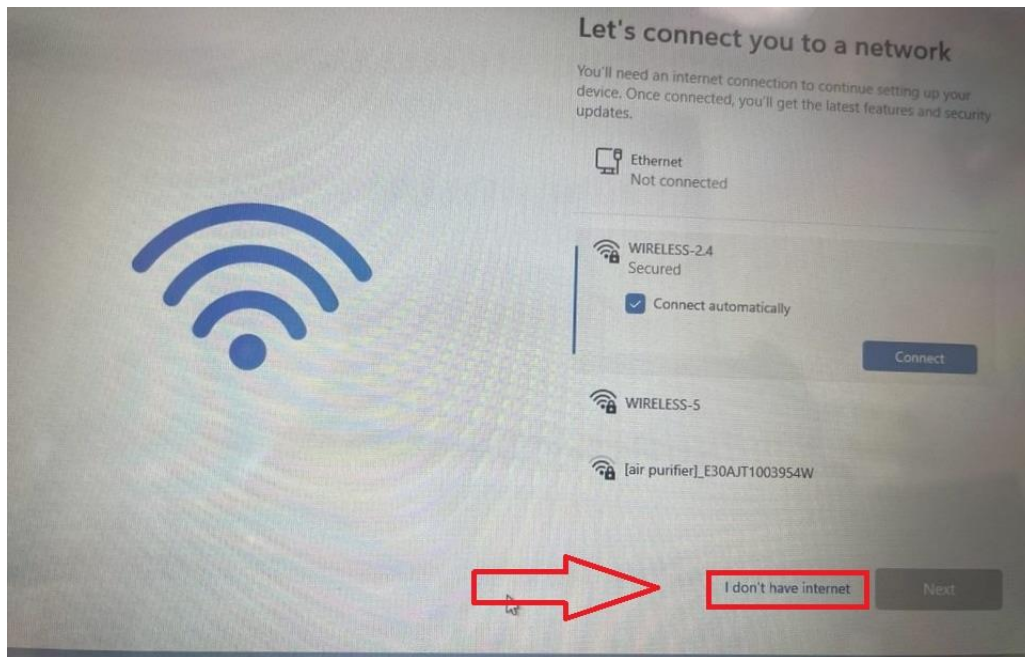
Step 4: You will see Let's connect you to a network page. There is no "I don't have internet" option here. Go to next or step 5



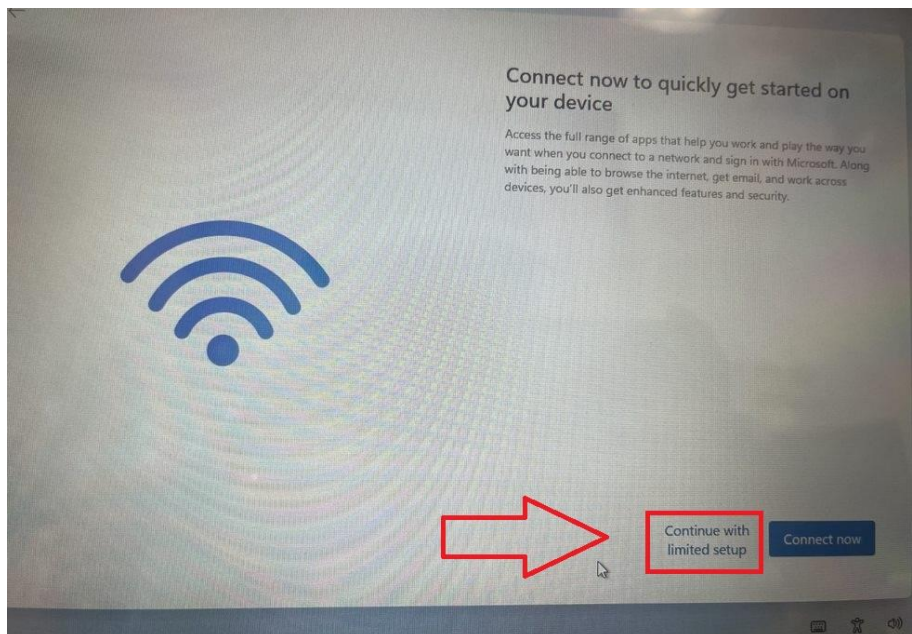
Step 5: On the same page, open Command Prompt with "Shift + F10" and type OOBE\BYPASSNRO and hit enter.



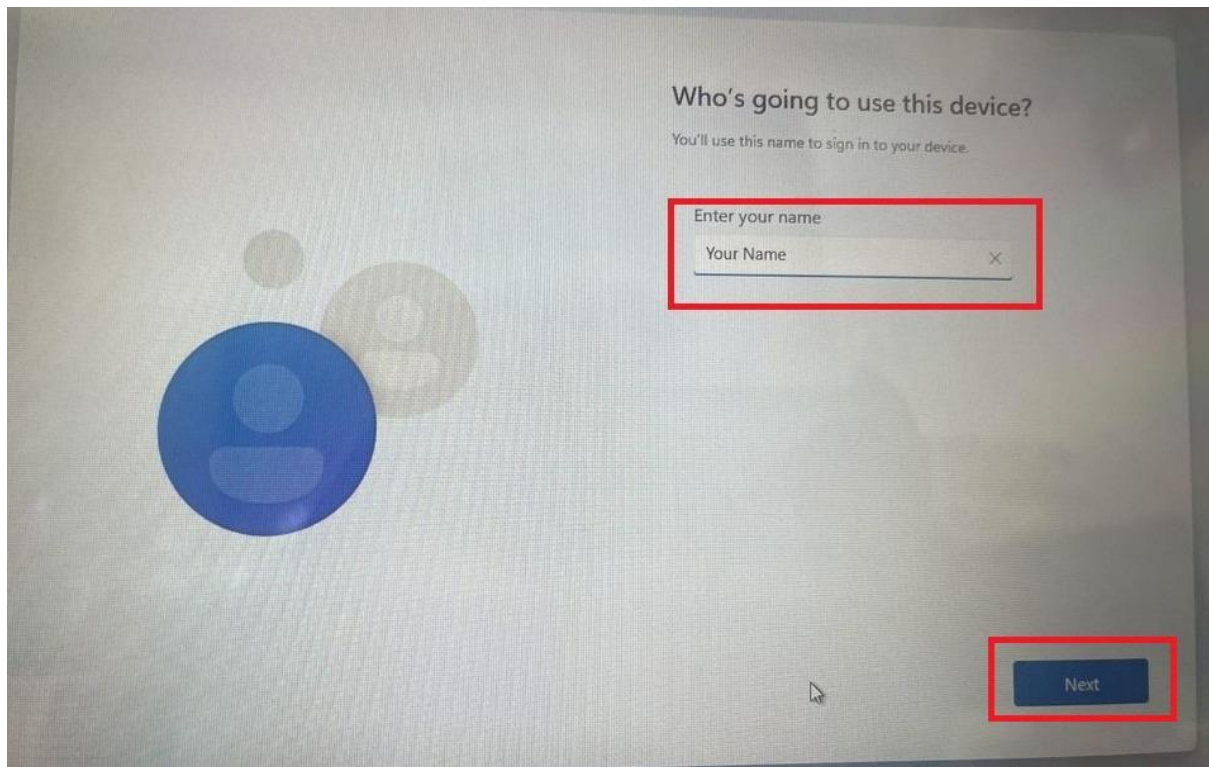
Step 6: Your computer will restart and now you will have the "I don't have Internet" option. Click on it and go to next.



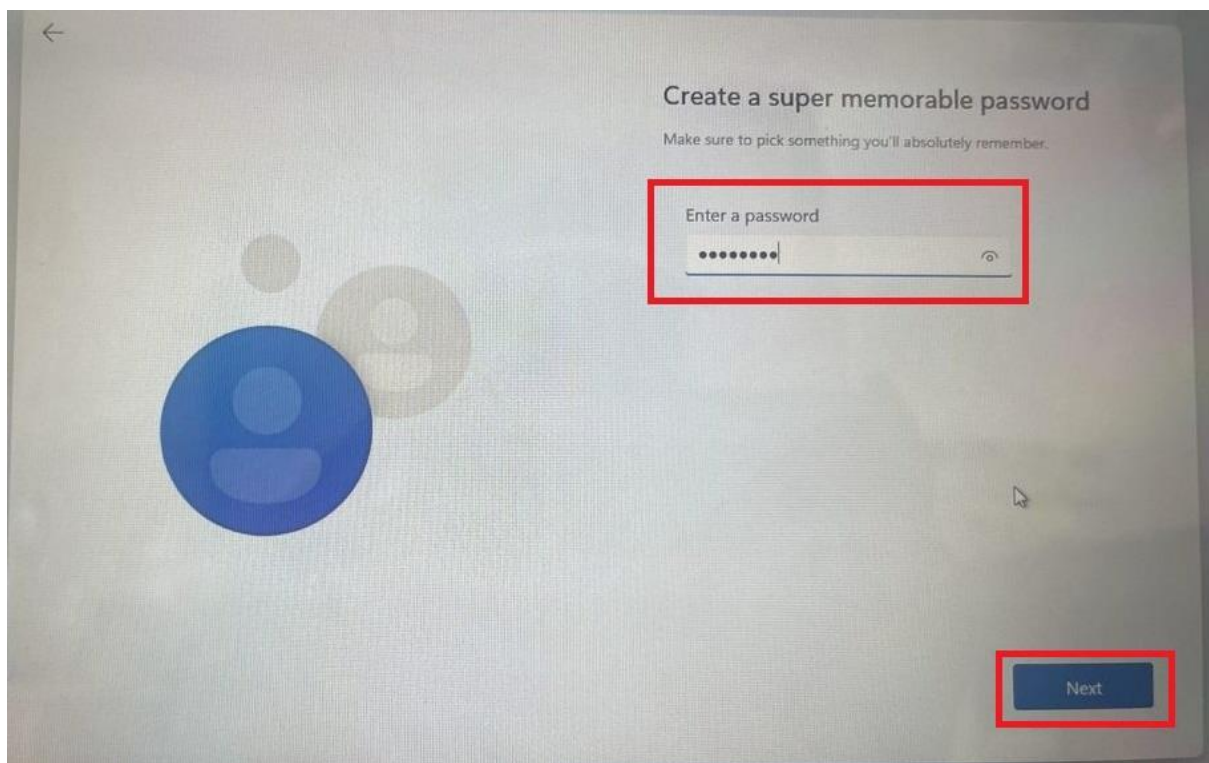
Step 7: Select "Continue with limited setup"



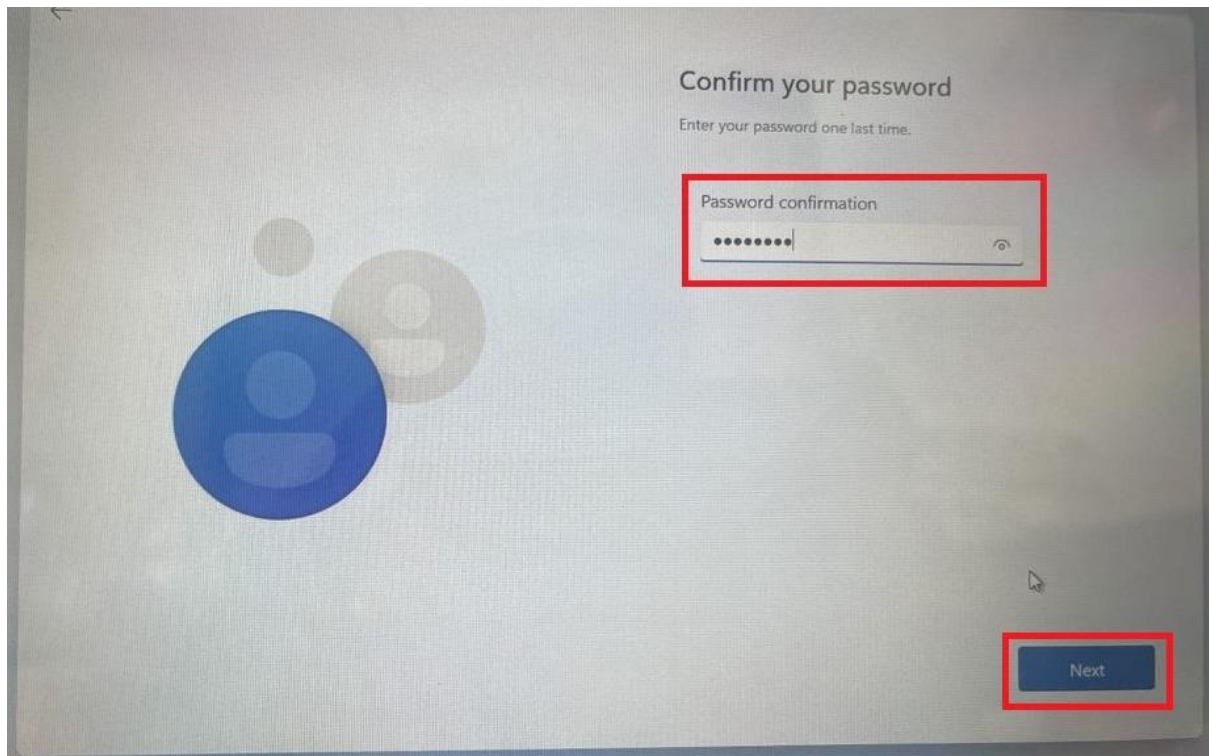
Step 8: Enter "name" for the account you are setting up on the laptop. Select Next.



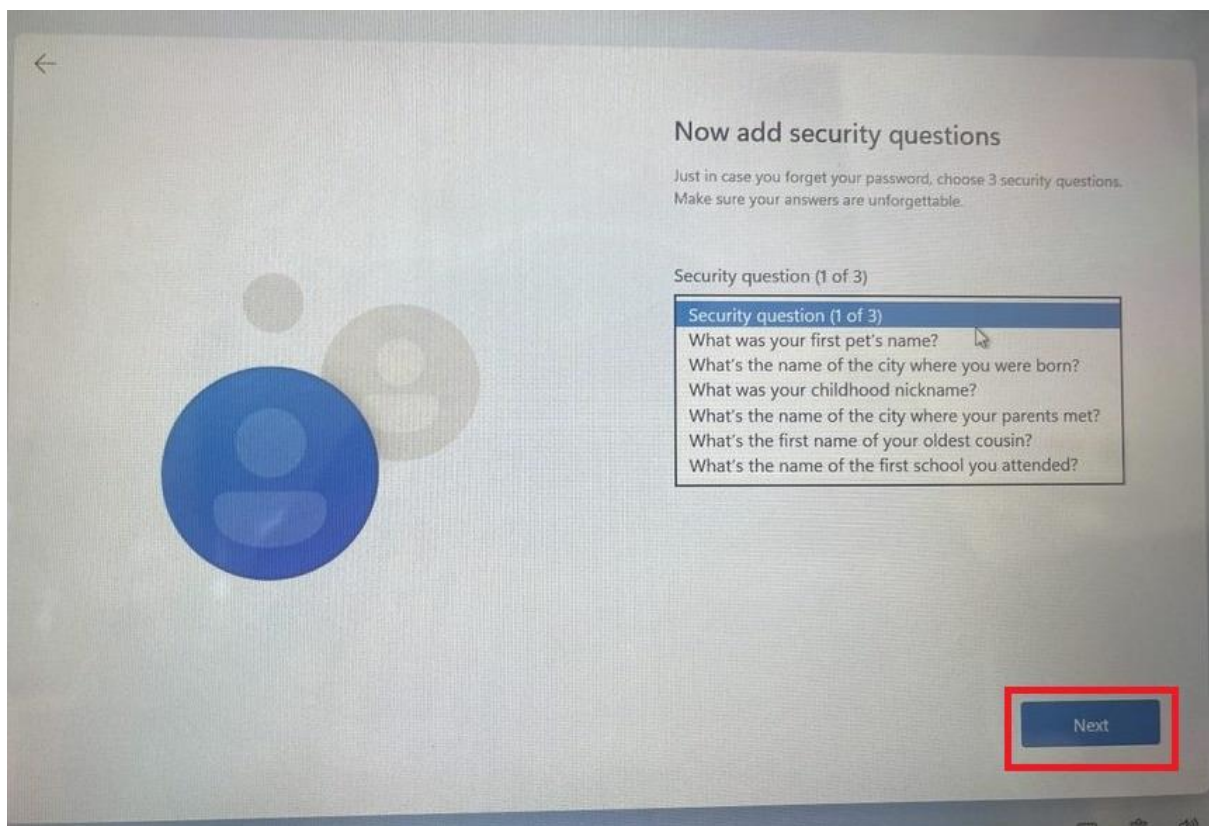
Step 9: Setup a password and make sure you remember or note it down somewhere. Select Next.



Step 10 : Confirm your password. Select Next.

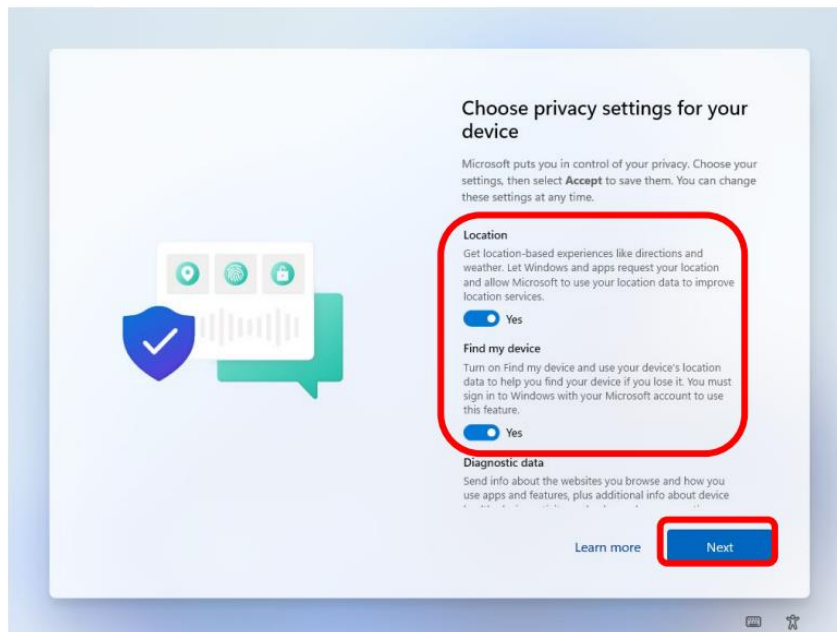


Step 11: Select a security question from the drop-down and setup your own answer. You need to setup 3 security questions and answers.



Step 12: Choose your privacy settings for your device. It is recommended to keep "Location" and "Find my Device" turned on. This will enable the device to be tracked

from your Microsoft Account if the device were to be lost or stolen. Please read through the other options and device if you wish to keep them on or off. Select "Next" when done.
