



Setup Windows 10 without Microsoft Account.


Step 1: Select Region- "Australia" and click on Yes




Step 2: For keyboard layout, select "US". Australia uses the same keyboard layout. Click Yes.




Step 3: Want to add a second keyboard layout? Select "Skip"




Step 4: On Lets connect you to a network window, select "I don't have internet" at the bottom left.




Step 5: Select "Continue with limited setup" at the bottom left.




Step 6: The PC will now restart and will ask to connect to the network again. Click on “I don’t have internet” again.




Step 7: Click on “Continue with limited setup” again.




Step 8: Enter "name" for the account you are setting up on the laptop. Select Next.




Step 9: Setup a password and make sure you remember or note it down somewhere secure. Select Next.



Step 10: Confirm your password. Select Next.




Step 11: Select a security question from the drop-down and setup your own answer. You need to setup 3 security questions and answers.




